

at 7 yards and second stage fired at 15 yards. Twenty second per stage starting with loaded gun in holster and including time to reload.




Match 2: Revolver, Kneeling and Standing Course at 25 Yards

reload. Time starts with shooter in standing position.




Match 3: Revolver, Sitting, Prone and Standing Course at 50 Yards







Stage 3.—15 yards—double action—12 shots, one or two hands, from standing without support position. Twenty seconds, includes reloading for second 6 shot string.

Stage 4. —25 yards—double action—18 shots, one or two hands; 6 shots kneeling, using the barricade for cover and support; 6 shots standing left hand from behind the barricade; and 6 shots standing right hand from behind the barricade. 

Stage 2. —25 yards-double action—6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing with support, left hand; 6 shots standing with support, right hand. 90 seconds, time starts with loaded gun in holster and includes reloading for subsequent 6 shot strings.

Stage 3. —50 yards-single or double action—6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left hand from behind barricade; 6 shots standing right hand from behind barricade. Two minutes and 45 seconds, time starts with loaded gun in holster and includes reloading for subsequent 6 shot strings.

Stage 4. —25 yards-double action—6 shots standing without support. Twelve seconds, time starts with loaded gun in holster. No barricade or other support is used.

MATCH 20 SHOTGUN MATCH



Match 20 – Shotgun:

Course of Fire: Practical Shotgun Course, as follows:

- a. 15 yards from the hip or shoulder, 5 rounds of 12-gauge 00 buckshot loaded with nine pellets per shell, fired at 4 B-27 targets in 10 seconds. Gun stock must be held under the arm until the targets start to turn. Gun may then be brought to the shoulder or fired from the underarm position.
- b. 20 yards, from the shoulder, with 5 rounds of 12-gauge 00 buckshot loaded with nine pellets per shell, fired at 4 B-27 targets in 5 seconds. Gun may be placed against the shoulder before the targets start to turn.

- c. 25 yards, from the shoulder, with 5 rounds of rifled slugs fired at 1 B-27 target in 10 seconds. Gun must be held under the arm until the targets start to turn.
- d. 45 yards, from the shoulder, from either the kneeling or standing position, with 5 rounds of rifled slugs fired at 1 B-27 target in 1 minute. Gun stock must be held under the arm until targets start to turn.

Guns Permitted: Competitors must furnish their own shotguns. They must be factory manufactured (catalog item), 12 gauge, barrel length not to exceed 21 inches, and no modifications. Barrel is to be cylinder bore; constriction at the choke may not exceed .0149. No screw-in chokes or back boring will be allowed. All safety devices provided by the manufacturer must function as designed.

Shotgun barrels will be checked for choke and inspected. NO REFIRES WILL BE ALLOWED FOR DEFECTIVE GUNS OR AMMUNITION. Shotguns brought to and from the range MUST be unloaded, actions open, safety on, muzzle up and uncased.

Sights: Metallic Sights Only.

Ammunition: Ammunition must be 12-gauge, 00 lead buckshot with nine pellets per shell, and 1 ounce rifled slugs. Ammunition will be inspected and a sample shell may be required for disassembly and examination. Reloaded or sabot ammunition will not be allowed.

Tie Breaking: Stage C (the rifled slug target); then Stage B (the back shot target). If a tie remains, it will be broken by the highest individual aggregate score (Rule 15.11h).
